




Global reach: 173 countries

Benefits for Affiliates

- 1. <u>Standardization process</u>: Access to IEC technical documents in electronic format and comment on CDs and CDVs
- 2. <u>Published IEC International Standards</u>: Selection of 200 free IEC International Standards (tailored to Affiliate's immediate needs and/or relevant domestic industries); and significant discount on any other additional standards; adoption of these 200 IEC International Standards as national standards free from any commercial consideration
- 3. IEC Conformity Assessment Systems
- Guidance to participate in IEC four Conformity Assessment Systems
- ACAS e-learning
- 4. <u>IEC Capacity building</u>: Assistance from IEC Central Office on how to establish a National Electrotechnical Committee and how to track technical projects of interest
- 5. <u>IEC General Meeting</u>: Attendance at meetings held during the IEC General Meeting including Council Statutory session (as observers)







- You will see the full list of IEC TC/SCs with information (picture below)








ACAS e-learning level 0
